## Phases of the Circle of Caring



Phase 1: Arrival. Left in a box, brought in as a stray, or surrendered by an owner, their journey begins here.



Phase 2: Medical Treatment. Injured and sick animals receive vital treatments and vaccinations. Unclaimed animals are sterilized prior to adoption.



Phase 3: Socialization and Training. Animals are temperament tested and given additional training or socialization through our staff and volunteers.



Phase 4: Waiting for a New Home. Maybe a few days, maybe a few months.



Phase 5: The Adoption Process. A Happy Ending in a New Home!
